<u>Definition of Alternate Pathways</u>: An Alternate Pathway program is one in which the student can complete his or her program without the need for face-to-face, daytime (M-F), Springfield course work. As such these programs are comprised of online, evening/weekend, off-campus, and iCourses—often as a combination of these delivery methods.

Rationale for Alternate Pathways Program Codes: Strategic plan support and monitoring student progress.

- Alternate Pathways Program Codes assist the University's long-range plan (Access to Success, Objective 1, Measure 2: total number of alternative pathways by program category).
- Definition of alternate pathways program codes allow for the identification, monitoring of, and outcome reporting of students pursuing a Missouri State University degree through these pathways.
