After competing the OTC AAT program and meeting the MSU admission requirements, students may seamlessly transfer to Missouri State and begin taking classes to complete a Bachelor's degree at the OTC campus in Lebanon.

Admission Requirements

Admission requirements to the MSU teacher education program include:

- GPA of 2.75 (combined)
- Pass all sections of the Missouri State Board of Education entry examination (MoGEA-passing score TBA)
- FCSR background check
- COM 105 grade of "C" or better
- All EDU classes completed with a grade of "C" or better
- Approved by Professional Education Committee
