For a strong education foundation, students are encouraged to complete the AAT via Crowder College coursework or Missouri Reverse Transfer (MRT).

ELE and ECE require a grade of C or higher in most General Education courses.

To complete MSU education degrees in 4 years (at Crowder and MSU including summers), students must follow specific 4 year plans provided by MSU. Special Education is excluded.

You must complete the MRT to graduate in 4 years with a Special Education degree.
