- Complete your associate's degree. The Associate
 of Arts in Teaching (AAT degree) is recommended
 because it will satisfy many of the requirements

 however, you may join this program with any AA
 degree if the appropriate prerequisites are taken.
- Pass the MoGEA assessments or have earned an ACT composite score of 20 or higher.
