BECOME A TEACHER BY COMPLETING YOUR BACHELOR'S OF SCIENCE IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION AT A LOCATION CLOSE TO YOU.

- 2 Finish your upper-division coursework through the MSU Outreach program in West Plains.
- Graduate from Missouri State certified to teach grades 1-6 in Missouri with a B.S. in Elementary Education

COHORTS BUILD YOUR PROFESSIONAL NETWORK NOW.

You'll enter the program with a cohort of peers. Take all your upper-division courses together. Enjoy small class sizes with your cohort. Study with local instructors — many are still teaching in classrooms, and can share relevant, recent field experience. Participate in practicums at schools in your area. You'll build your network of peers and professionals in the community where you live and work.

The elementary education bachelor's completion program is an evening program. Classes start after 4 p.m.

TRANSFER TO MISSOURI STATE

TRANSFER YOUR DEGREE, BUT STAY WHERE YOU ARE.

Complete your bachelor's degree with Missouri State Outreach. Take online, zoom, and seated upper-division courses in West Plains. No need to travel to Springfield to take classes. Save travel time and money by earning your degree at-a-distance.

BEFORE YOU TRANSFER

During your first year in the AAT program, meet with MSU Outreach staff early and often to determine when you will be ready to apply and then transfer.
